If you are unsure of the best program for your skater please email office@wtsc.ca and provide the following information: Age, Skating history and Days and Times you are available to come to the rink

If your skater is new or returning to WTSC and you wish to register for a:

LEARN TO SKATE program

If the skater is 3-5 years old and has not skated before please register for:

- PRE CANSKATE

CSA Hockey Helmets mandatory. All skaters not passed Stage 1. Min. age 3 by Sept 1, 2019. Session consists of 30 minute group lesson. Parents are encouraged to join the concurrent Teen/Adult CanSkate session.

If the skater is 4-13 years old and has not skated before or has participated in CANSKATE (or equivalent) before please register for:

- CANSKATE

CSA Hockey Helmets mandatory. Skaters passed Pre-CanSkate or are min. age 4 by Dec 31, 2019. Session consists of a 45 minute group lesson

If the skater is 4-13 years old and has participated in CANSKATE (or equivalent) before and you would like them to learn **FIGURE SKATING** skills please register for:

- RisingSTAR

By invitation / approval of Program Director. Passed Stage 2 CanSkate and *interested in figure skating*. Fee includes 45 minutes of group lesson on ice and applicable off-ice.** Helmets mandatory for skaters not passed Stage 5 CanSkate

If the skater is a TEEN (14 to 18) and has not skated before please register for:

- TEEN/ADULT CANSKATE

CSA Hockey Helmets mandatory. All stages offered for ages 14+. Knee pads and wrist guards are encouraged.

- TEEN/ADULT CANSKATE

CSA Hockey Helmets mandatory. All stages offered for ages 14+. Knee pads and wrist guards are encouraged.

If you are a TEEN (14+) or Adult who has joined CANSKATE (or equivalent) before please register for: (2 Options)

- TEEN/ADULT CANSKATE (Recommended)

CSA Hockey Helmets mandatory. All stages offered for ages 14+. Knee pads and wrist guards are encouraged.

- CANSKATE (This would be a Teen/Adult group on the ice along with skaters Aged 4 to 13)

CSA Hockey Helmets mandatory. Skaters passed Pre-CanSkate or are min. age 4 by Dec 31, 2019. Session consists of a 45 minute group lesson.

If you are a TEEN (14+) or Adult who has joined CANSKATE (or equivalent) before and would like to work on **FIGURE SKATING** Skills please register for:

-TEEN/ADULT RISINGSTAR

For teens and adults (age 14+) working on Stage 1 CanSkate and up (Move forwards/backwards/glide on two feet/stop) Fee includes ice time and 30 minute group lesson.

All skaters will be assessed on their first session and will be placed into a group based on their skill level.

If your skater is coming from another Skate Canada Club, please email us a copy of their last report card if possible.

Skaters are strongly encouraged to skate at least 2 days per week during the Fall/Winter season in order to progress.

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Age, Skating history and Days and Times you are available to come to the rink

The annual Skate Canada fee \$43.65 and the annual Club fee of \$25 will be added to your first registration of each season (Sept. 1 - Aug. 31).
